

Efficient Cast

An efficient cast of Brisbane Repertory Theatre players gave a good showing in Terence Rattigan's comedy drama "Flare Path," in the Albert Hall last night.

Standard of acting was commensurate with that of professional artists in the writer's previous successes here—"French Without Tears" and "While the Sun Shines."

Plot was wafer-thin, delineating simply characters' reactions to crashes on the flare path of a near-by aerodrome.
